1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of US SAILING.
- 1.2. The rules of the CFJ Class, the Shadden Series Standing Rules as published in the 2009 SCYYRA Year Book and the 2009-2010 Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race, the Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions will also apply.
- 1.3. RRS 35, 40.1, 75.3 and Race Signals will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to CFJ Class boats that meet the following requirements:
 - a. The skipper and crew shall be under 21 years of age.
 - b. The skipper and crew shall be members of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
 - c. The skipper and crew shall be members of US SAILING.
 - d. One crewmember on each boat must be a member, in good standing, of the CFJ Class. For general and class membership information, contact the CFJ Class at www.cfjclass.org.
- 2.2. Registration will be available at www.sdyc.org/juniors. Registration must be completed by 1600 January 29, 2010 with a \$30.00 entry fee. Entries may be received until 0930 on Saturday January 30, 2010 with a \$10.00 late fee.
- 2.3. Boats not already registered in the Shadden Series may compete in this regatta, but will not be scored in the 2009-2010 Shadden Series.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at check in on January 30, 2010.

5 RACING

- 5.1. The racing area will be approximately 1 NM southeast of Zuniga Jetty in the area known as the Coronado Roads.
- 5.2. Sailors should be prepared for a long day on the water.
- 5.3. A sport lunch consisting of water, beef jerky, nutrition bars, fruit and trail mix will be provided for all registered competitors. Competitors are advised to bring additional water/sports drinks as it will be a long day on the water.
- 5.4. All boats must have a bowline of at least 25 feet for towing purposes.

6 COURSES

6.1. The courses to be sailed will be as follows: triangle, windward-leeward, or any combination thereof.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply.

8 SCORING

8.1. This regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A using the Low Point System. Two races will constitute a regatta.

9 SUPPORT/SPECTATOR BOATS

9.1. Spectator boats will not be provided.

9.2. Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished the race or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

10 TRAILERS

10.1. All trailers should be stored in the lot adjacent to the tennis courts; any trailer parked along the side fence may be moved or towed at the discretion of the dockmaster.

10.2. Competitors must provide their own dollies and all boats must be clear of the fire lanes.

10.3. Support boats will be berthed in the whaler slip adjacent to the Jr. Dock. No boats may be tied up in private slips.

11 TROPHIES

11.1. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top three teams at the regatta.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 HOSPITALITY

13.1. San Diego Yacht Club is in the middle of an extensive construction project. We apologize but parking will be for members only and our boatyard space is extremely limited so trailers may be moved over the course of the weekend.

13.2. Lunch is provided for all competitors.

13.3. There will be a snack for competitors after racing each day.

13.4. Guests may register with the SDYC front desk for a guest card. The dining room and bar will open at 1100.
