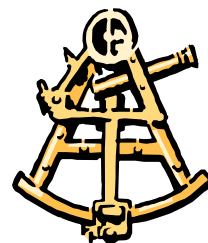


NOTICE OF RACE AND ENTRY  
2008 PORT CAPTAIN'S RACE  
AROUND BISHOP ROCK  
AUGUST 15 - 17, 2008



1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the current *rules* as defined by the **Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)**.
- 1.2 In accordance with the **PHRF Rule Section 10**, this shall be a **Category I** race with its associated safety requirements.
- 1.3 **All boats entered must have a registered 406 MHz EPIRB on board during the race.**
- 1.4 The all classes shall be handicapped according to PHRF of Southern California "Random Leg" ratings.
- 1.5 **PHRF Class Rule 10.5** is omitted for Short-handed entries only. Short-handed is defined, for the purpose of this regatta, as three or less persons on board. Use of autopilots or self-steering equipment for all *PHRF Short-Handed* entries is specifically **allowed**.
- 1.6 Competitors in the Short-handed division are required to wear PFD's or Harnesses **at all times**.
- 1.7 Competitors in all other divisions are required to wear PFD's or Harnesses **from sundown to sun up**.
- 1.8 This event shall be designated a **Category C** event in accordance with ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20.

2. ENTRY

This regatta is open to mono-hull vessels with a **current** PHRF certificate of rating equal to or less than 120, whose owner or charterer is a member of a yacht club affiliated with US Sailing, her National Authority, or the ISAF.

The following classes will compete: PHRF and Short-handed. (Short-handed is defined as three or less persons on board).

Additional classes may be formed by requests to the Sailing Office at San Diego Yacht Club prior to August 7, 2008.

There must be a **minimum of five paid entries received by Thursday, August 7, 2008 to make a regatta.**

There must be a **minimum of two boats entered to form a class.**

The PHRF class breaks will be at the discretion of the Race Chairman.

All PHRF entrants must be current members of a PHRF Fleet.

4. ADVANCE REGISTRATION AND DEADLINE

- 4.1 Entry forms are available at the website ([www.sdyc.org/raceinfo](http://www.sdyc.org/raceinfo)).
- 4.2 **Subject to NOR 2.3, entries close Wednesday, August 13 at 1200.** Late entries accepted at the discretion of the regatta chair.
- 4.3 Entries with no record of any PHRF certificate will not be considered for late entry.
- 4.4 Entry Fee is \$75 prior to 1700, August 1. Entry fee there after until close of entries at 1200, 8/13/08 is \$100.
- 4.5 Entry fee is payable to San Diego Yacht Club.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND CLASS BREAKS

Sailing Instructions and Class Breaks will be available no later than 1700, Wednesday, August 13, 2008 at SDYC Sailing Office at 758-6310 or on our website at [www.sdyc.org/raceinfo](http://www.sdyc.org/raceinfo).

6. NEW COURSE AND RACING AREA

- 6.1 The racing area will be the offshore waters of Southern California up to 100 miles out.
- 6.2 The approximate course will begin in the vicinity of Ship Rock at Isthmus Cove, Catalina Island, leave West End, Catalina to port, leave Santa Barbara Island to port, leave buoy R "2CB" (Bishop Rock) to port and finish at buoy RW "SD" San Diego Channel Entrance Buoy. The exact course with bearings, lat/lon's and distances will be detailed in the SIs.
- 6.3 Approximate handicap distance is 189 nm. Reference Chart: NOAA 18740.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 Ratings are Random Leg Ratings established by PHRF of Southern California.
- 7.2 Trophies and hosted reception on Sunday, August 17, at 1500 hrs on the Lower Front Deck of San Diego Yacht Club.
- 7.3 All boats completing the course shall be given a finish.
