Updated - Notice of Race **2009 YVONKA INTERNATIONAL RACE**

1 RULES

- 1.1** This regatta shall be governed by the *Rules* as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, and the COLREGS (International Rules of Preventing Collisions at Sea).
- 1.2** The Race will be sailed as a "pursuit," start whereby boats start individually at an assigned start time with slowest boat going first followed progressively by faster boats. All boats will sail in one class. A provisional start time sheet will be posted on the Official Notice Board at SDYC no later than 1700, Friday July 10, 2009.
- 1.3** Oral changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made while on the water. If such a change is necessary, the RC will fly the "L" flag (Come within hail) and "C" flag to note such a change is being made. This change may also be made over the VHF Ch. 69.
- 1.4** There will be NO requirement to report to Customs Dock. Recreational vessels leaving a United States port into international or foreign waters, without a call at a foreign port, are not considered to have made a departure for the purposes of Customs and Boarder Protection reporting requirements. However, we will be providing to the CBP a roster of competitors associated with our event.

2 ENTRY AND CLASSES

- 2.1** There is no entry fee.
- 2.2** This regatta is open to mono-hulled boats with no limit on number of crew.
- 2.3** **Five registered boats will be required to constitute a regatta.**
- 2.4** All yachts will be assigned an individual start time by the Race Committee. The intent is for all boats to arrive at the finish as close as possible.
- 2.5** Entries are due in the Sailing Office by 1600, Friday, July 10.
 - 2.5.1** Enter online (www.sdyc.org/raceinfo). Click on the Yvonka link under Upcoming Events.
 - 2.5.2** To request a paper entry form, please contact the Sailing Office 619/758-6309.
- 2.6** Start times will be posted on the SDYC Official Notice Board and emailed to all registered competitors by 1700 on Friday, July 10.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

The warning signal for **Saturday will be at 1025**. The warning signal for **Sunday will be at 1155**.

The Race Committee will monitor VHF 69 and provide starting information for competitors if requested.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS and START TIMES

Sailing Instructions and start times will be available no later than 1700, Friday July 10 at SDYC Official Notice Board.

6. RACING AREA

The starting area on Day 1 will be in the vicinity of Zuniga Jetty. The starting area for Day 2 will be in the vicinity of South Coronado Island.

7. SCORING

Boats will be afforded a time allowance at the beginning of the race. Scoring shall be as described in Appendix A using the Low Point Scoring System.
